## Drill operators levels of competency

### C Class - Basic Operator

#### This Operator :

- \* Can operate a D75KS Drill but requires some supervision.
- \* Has difficulties understanding and communicating instructions.
- \* Is a new operator learning inspections, servicing and gaining operating experience.
- \* Is unable to identify Drill components.
- \* Has had limited exposure to drilling operations.
- \* Has operated D75KS Drills for a long period of time but cannot demonstrate good operating techniques.

### B Class Operator

#### This Operator :

- \* Needs minimal supervision.
- \* Can service, but infrequently carries out maintenance inspections on the Drill.
- \* Can operate a D75KS Drill in a safe and competent manner.
- \* Can identify some D75KS components.
- \* Operates the Drill below the expected competency criteria.
- \* Not used on the Drill full time, but can achieve acceptable drilling rates.

### A Class Operator

#### This Operator :

- \* Can operate the Drill unsupervised in any location across the mine site.
- \* Can identify a large majority of the D75KS components.
- \* Can service, carries out maintenance inspections, reports faults and follows up on defects.
- \* Is able to liaise with previous shift personnel to ascertain what requirements, if any, are needed before commencing his shift.
- \* Can supervise a job and is able to instruct others.
- \* Can achieve all performance tests required for a D75KS competency and proficiency standards.
- \* Will plan his shift prior to start up or request assistance as required.
- \* Is able to read a Drilling Plan and can liaise with the Engineer in the event the plan is not in accordance with the bench conditions.
- \* Has the initiative to organise consumables or materials, if any are required throughout his shift.
- \* Can train others in the correct operating procedures on the D75KS Drill.
